Contest Rules:

1. Eligibility for “All You Need Is Love and A Free Wedding” (the Contest) is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of entry. Online: The method of entry will be available by visiting www.theviewsatsuperstition.com. Follow the instructions provided to fill out the entry information. Limit one (1) entry per couple. Entries received from any person, e-mail address, or household in excess of the stated limitation will be void. All contestants must be either unmarried; divorced or widowed is acceptable.

6. Must be Present to win: Come to the Open House on January 16, 2019 from 5-8pm. Drawing will be held at approximately 7pm. One person is allowed to accept the winning ticket. The couple is not required to attend together, however it is highly encouraged both are present.

7. Only one ticket needed to win: Contestants will receive one ticket at the door the day of the Open House on January 16, 2019. If you're not able to come, you may have someone come in your place. Please make arrangements with The Views At Superstition to notify who is coming in your place.

8. Free Wedding is non transferrable. Contestant cannot give their winning ticket to someone else.

You may change the date providing all vendors are available and all agree to the date change. Date changes are subject to additional fees determined by the venue and the vendors.

14. **Additional Free Services includes:** The venue includes all the tables, chairs, ivory linens, glass centerpieces and balcony or inside ceremony. The catering includes a custom menu with bread service, first course salad, gourmet entrée from Aroma Catering, , DJ/MC from AZ Celebrity DJ, Cake from Graceful Cake Creations By Gracie, Bartender by April Spirits, Bride Bouquet & groom boutonniere from Wild Iris Weddings, Groom Tux from Celebrity Tux & Tails, 2 hour Photography & 1 hour photobooth from Lia's Photography, and Officiant from Bird of Paradise Weddings –Additional guests and upgrades for up to 200 may be added at our advertised price. 15. **Vendor Services:** Each sponsoring vendor will determine the budget for each service. You will have the option for upgrading where necessary, there is not an unlimited budget for all the goods and services. The Views at Superstition reserves to right to maintain and control budgets for all goods and services for your 50 guests. The sponsor is not liable if a donation is cancelled or withdrawn. The sponsor will try to replace the donation, but is not held accountable if they cannot find another vendor to do so.

16. The winner will need to consent to use their names and photographs in promotional materials for The Views at Superstition as well as the vendors sponsoring their wedding. The winner will also need to consent to a background check if necessary.

17. General Conditions:

In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Contest is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, bug, worm, unauthorized human intervention or other technical problem, or in the event the Contest is unable to run as planned for any other reason, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either (a) suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Sweepstakes in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules or (b) terminate the Sweepstakes and, in the event of termination, award the prize at random from among the eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of the impairment.
